It has been a busy start to the year with the club successfully promoting two open races and gaining wins and podiums on road, MTB and track. events

The Les Ingman Memorial Road Race attracted a full field of top local riders and was convincingly won by Roy Chamberlain, Team Phil Corley Cycles on a cool windy day. Simon Coles was the highest placed Paragon, finishing 13th and won the Harry Grant Silver Wheel for his efforts.

Entries were slightly down on last year for Robin Buchan Memorial 25 Mile Time Trial and as usual the event produced a worthy winner in Mike Coyle, Brighton Mitre CC with a time of 54:30. The cold northerly wind took its toll on riders over the closing miles and consequently times were slower than normal. The event also included the Mayne Cup with Carolyn Heeps making good use of her 18 min handicap to win the club’s oldest cup with a net time of 56:03. Jon Masters won the Imperial Wheelers Cup for fastest time (57:11) and second h;cap (56:11).

On the road James Stuart and Simon Coles have both won Surrey League races and many others have gained top three finishes. Steve Watkins and Kaye Patton have featured frequently in the top three of their category in mountain bike races. While on the track Simon Warren has been flying the flag in omnium events.

The Evening TT Series has been contested by 14 different members with Andy Davies, leading the series and Jon Masters, Dan Sullivan and James Stuart all in close contention for overall honours.
