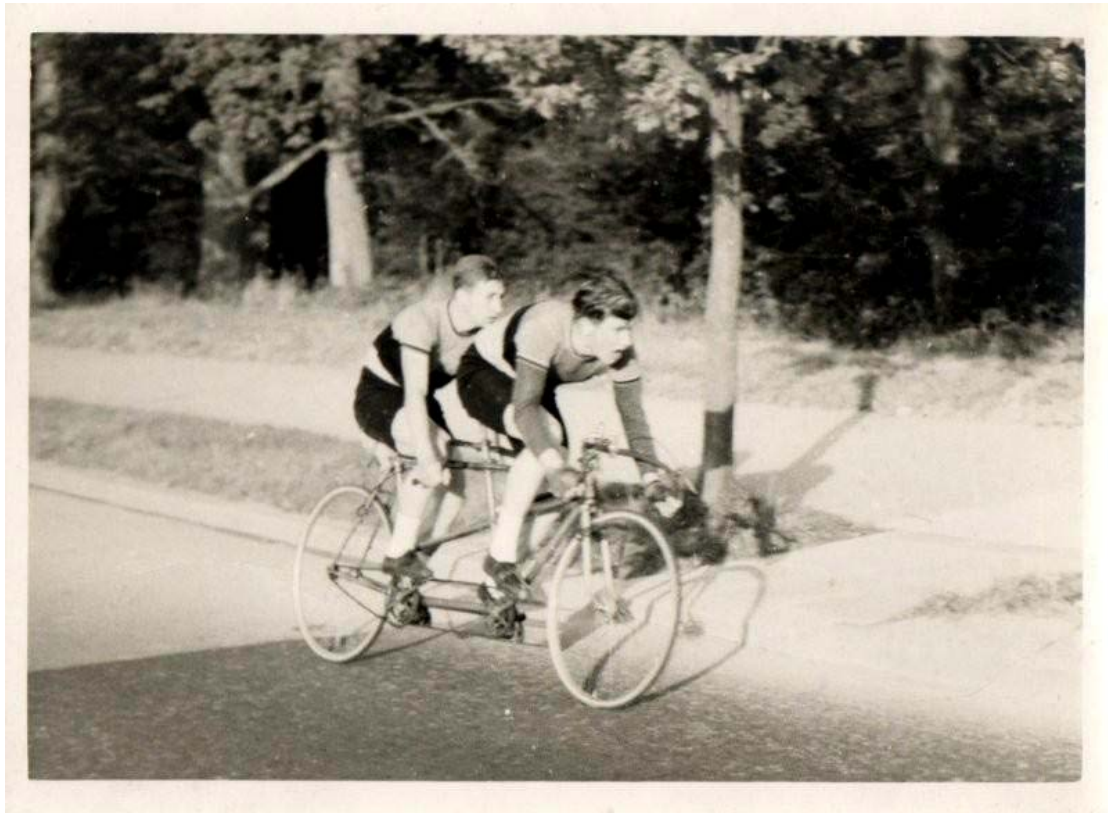

The Club season started with the medium Gear '25' on the Pound Hill course. Thirteen had entered and nine started. This was a surprise as it was snowing heavily and the snow was not melting! Robin Buchan still managed to win in a time that must have been his slowest ever for a '25' – 1.11.26. R Williamson was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 1.12.42 and Pete Smith 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1.13.58. The handicap went to Williamson with a nett 1.8.42 but he only just beat John Smart by 3 seconds. In 3<sup>rd</sup> place was Pete Smith in 1.9.28.

By the following week the snow had melted and in the Dartford Whs Medium gear Robin Buchan was 4<sup>th</sup> in 1.4.12 (which gives some idea of the better conditions). New member John Llewellyn was also up with the leaders with 1.4.33, John Pocock did 1.7.01 and Jerry Morritt 1.12.27. The Paragon collected the Team race. In the SCCU event our fastest rider was Alan Sturgess with 1.8.20 that was good enough to collect 2<sup>nd</sup> on handicap. Ron Stempfer finished in 1.9.18, Gerry Pearl 1.15.21 and Mick Green 1.16.15.

There were high hopes the following week-end that were promptly dashed when Robin Buchan punctured in the Calleva Medium Gear '25'. Micky Vickers finished with 1.6.54 just in front of John Pocock 1.6.59. The new kids on the block, five of them, rode the Kentish Whs Novices '25'. P Tilley was fastest Paragonian in 1.8.37, Brian Quinton 1.11.20, Vic Boreham 1.12.10, Paul Jaegar 1.12.21 and R Tutton 1.12.25.

Twenty-two riders finished the Club '25' on the 27<sup>th</sup> March and once again Robin Buchan was fastest in 1.3.17. Pete Smith was his closest rival in 1.4.46 with Micky Vickers 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1.5.16. Vic Boreham took the handicap with a nett 58.44 nearly a minute faster than P Tilley, 59.36, and Pete Smith 59.46.

We had four finishers in the Apollo Middlemarkers with Alan Sturgess finishing in 2<sup>nd</sup> place. His 1.4.42 also beat Ray Johnson's 1.5.24, Brian Newcombe's 1.5.34 and Bruce Smith's 1.10. However the first three were fast enough to take the Team race. Messrs Ward, Llewellyn and Buchan rode the Oxonian '25'. Don Ward finished in 1.2.06 and John Llewellyn 1.5.57. Any thoughts of a Team race win were dashed when Robin Buchan punctured and failed to finish.

Easter Sunday and Robin Buchan rode the Fountain '25' and recorded a 1.1 and John Pocock a 1.4.32. Doug Perry went west to the Worcester St Johns '25' where he finished in 1.7.44. On the Monday the Team rode the Actonia '25'. Robin Buchan was the best of our riders in 1.2.44, Micky Vickers 1.4.15, Jerry Morrit 1.8.39 and John Pocock 1.8.47. Me thinks it was a hard morning!

The 17<sup>th</sup> April saw the Time-triallist scattered all around the country. On the Brighton Road Terry Dixon finished the Bec '25' in 1.5.53. In Essex the Marsh '25' had to be split into two events as they had so many entries. Don Ward finished in 1.1.48 and John Llewellyn 1.2.24 on one course and Ron Palmer did 1.3.08 on the other. In Berkshire Wally Happy collected 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the Harlequin Middlemarkers '25' with a 1.4.38 and behind him were Brian Newcombe 1.6.07, Chris Gray 1.7.13 and Doug Perry 1.10.30. John Gallo won the Delta Longmarkers '25' with a 1.7.02 with P Tutton finishing in 1.15.18. In Hertfordshire Robin Buchan paired with Dave Hill (Kentish Whs) won the University Tandem '30' in 1.4.28 and Micky Vickers finished with a 1.4.36 in the Leicester Forest '25'.

Things were not quite as successful the next weekend but the events ridden were just as well scattered. John Pocock was our fastest rider in the SCCU '50' with 2.12.58, John Gallo was next with 2.16.46 and the other finisher was Alan Sturgess in 2.20.25. We also had a team in the Swindon Whs '50'. Don Ward was fastest of ours in 2.6.43, John Llewellyn finished in 2.10.15 but Micky Vickers failed to finish. Robin Buchan rode the Hitchin Nomads '25' and completed the distance in 1.3.10. Nearer home the team in the Clarence Middlemarkers '25' recorded these times; Terry Dixon 1.7.18, Pete Wall 1.14.27, Geoff Osbourne 1.15.52.

Fourteen riders finished the Dave London '30' with Ray Johnson recording fastest time with 1.18.01 that also gave him the Dave London Trophy as he won the handicap section as well. Brian Stocking was 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest in 1.18.24 and John Pocock 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1.19.32. John Gallo took 2<sup>nd</sup> handicap with a nett 1.15.47 with Terry Dixon 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1.16.14. The big boys were out on the Southend Road for the Brentwood '25'. Their times were Robin Buchan 1.0.58, Don Ward 1.2.07, Mickey Vickers 1.2.13, Ron Palmer 1.2.46 and John Llewellyn 1.3.20 with a puncture.

Another quiet day on the 8<sup>th</sup> May. John Llewellyn 1.0.30 and Don Ward 1.2.25 finished the North Bucks '25'. Ron Palmer rode the Cambrian '50' and finished with a 2.9. Robin Buchan, again paired with Dave Hill, came 2<sup>nd</sup> with 1.3.57 in the Portsmouth Tandem '30'.

Things perked up on the 15<sup>th</sup> as Robin Buchan came in with a 59.38 to win the De Laune '25' on the Cherry Tree course. Don Ward finished in 1.2.17 and Micky Vickers 1.2.56 to round off the winning Team. Another three riders were well to the fore in the WLCA '25'. Chris Gray did 1.4.23, Brian Newcombe 1.5.06 and John Gallo 1.5.52. Ron Palmer and John Llewellyn stayed closer to home and recorded 1.6.02 and 1.4.25 respectively in the Gravesend '25'. Doug Perry went touring and finished the SCCU '100' in 5.33.30 unless that is a misprint in the Time Trial secretary's notebook.

If the weekend of the 22nd May was good the following weekend was better. Robin Buchan won the Woolwich '25' in 1.2.59, John Llewellyn was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 1.3.02, Don Ward finished in 1.4.49 and the Paragon won the Team race. Another team rode the Catford '50'. Micky Vickers finished in 2.9.38, Ron Palmer 2.13.08 and John Pocock 2.14.02 to win the Team race. A third team rode the Elsynge Middlemarkers '25' but they were not so fortunate. Brian Newcombe was our fastest rider in 1.5.38; Chris Gray recorded 1.5.43 and John Barclay 1.12.47.

Back on home ground the following weekend Robin produced another under-the-hour ride of 59.22 to finish 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Bellingham '25'. Don Ward finished in 1.0.27 and Harry Corby 1.4.00. Mickey Vickers and Ron Palmer went over to Essex for the Goodmayes '50'. Mick did 2.6.55 and Ron 2.9 something after a puncture. No prizes are mentioned in the report. It was also a blank day for the Team that went down south to the Portsmouth '25' as two of them managed to start late. Best rider was John Gallo with 1.6.44 but Pete Wall managed a 1.14.53 and Geoff Osborne a 1.31.43 after their contre-temps.

Alan Large won the SCCU road race Championship with Gerry Pearl in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, Brian Stocking 6<sup>th</sup> and Geoff Huntingdon 7<sup>th</sup>. Needless to say the Paragon won the Team.

Great Days for the Paragon in National 25 Miles Championship. Robin Buchan came 2<sup>nd</sup> in 57.55, John Llewellyn finished in 59.20 and Don Ward made up the WINNING TEAM with a 1.1.34. Robin missed 1<sup>st</sup> place by just 4 seconds

Back home the rest of the time triallist were riding the Moon Trophy '50'. The times recorded are: - John Gallo 2.10.31, Chris Gray 2.10.45, Brian Newcombe 2.11.14, Harry Corby 2.11.45, Terry Dixon 2.17.10, Geoff Osborne 2.24.14 and Doug Perry 2.21.00. The Club won the Team race but no record has been made of which riders were in the Team for this competition is decided on Handicap times. Mickey Vickers sneaked off to the Brighton Mitre '50' on his own but was rewarded with a 2.14.36 and a puncture.

The 12<sup>th</sup> June saw the Paragon collect another individual win and another Team win when Ray Johnson won the Anerley Middlemarkers '25' with a 1.6.33. Brian Newcombe was also close to the front with a 1.6.49 and with Chris Gray coming home with a 1.8.25 the Team race was ours. Bruce Smith also rode and finished with a 1.11.21. On the same day five club riders were down for the SCCU and Club '100' but only two made it to the Finish. John Gallo completed the ride in 4.55.15 after losing 8 minutes but how and why is not noted. Ron Palmer took 4.59.58 on his ride that also included time off the bike with punctures.

Better luck came the Paragon way on the 19<sup>th</sup> June in the Chichester '50' and some very close packing. Robin Buchan finished in 2.4.25, Johnny Llewellyn 2.4.53 and Don Ward 2.4.55 to take the Team race. Also riding were Mickey Vickers, 2.6.12, and Ron Palmer 2.13.06. The Hoi-Poloi of the Club was riding from Purley to Brighton, all seventeen of them. Fastest by 2.34 was Brian Stocking who crossed the line in 1.34.27. John Gallo was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 1.37.01 and Chris Gray 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1.37.34. Paul Jaeger took the Handicap by 12" from Vic Boreham, 1.33.08 to 1.33.20, with Eric Bonner 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1.34.35.

Following the success of the 25 miles National Championship the lads went off to ride the National 50 miles Championship with high hopes. In spite of good rides by all they only managed to collect 3<sup>rd</sup> Team award. Robin Buchan was our fastest rider with a personal best ride of 2.1.55; Johnny Llewellyn did 2.3.06, Mickey Vickers 2.4.23 and Don Ward 2.7.58. Closer to home Harry Corby went round the Kentish Whs '100' in 4.42.24.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> July Robin Buchan went down to the New Forest and won the Bournemouth Jubilee '25' in 59.15. The other of the '50' Team consoled themselves by riding the Oxford City '50'. Although much slower than the National Johnny Llewellyn finished the course in 2.4.02, Mickey Vickers 2.9.12 and Don Ward 2.9.17, to collect the Team race. Meanwhile John Gallo and Brian Newcombe endeavoured to get equal times in the WLCA '50'. Brian did 2.10.54 and John 2.10.59.

Next week-end the fast lads went to ride the Kingston RC '25'. Robin Buchan was our fastest rider in 59.05. With backing from Don Ward, 1.2.03, and Harry Corby 1.3.57, they collected the Team race. In the Kent RC 2<sup>nd</sup> Class '25' Chris Gray was 3<sup>rd</sup> fastest in 1.3.01, Brian Newcombe was a mite slower in 1.3.05 and Alan Sturgess was third man in 1.6.35.

On the 17<sup>th</sup> July Alan Large is reported as having done a 1.0.26 in the Regent '25' but no position is given. What is more intriguing is the terse note " Club 25 ABANDONED! No reason given!

Two faces and names no longer to be seen in the English cycling scene were Maurice Jeffries and Ron Stretton who sailed to Canada on the 25<sup>th</sup> July to start a new life.

Another win followed in the Bromley '25' when Johnny Llewellyn scored with a 1.1.03. Mickey Vickers was 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1.3.01 and with Brian Stocking close up with a 1.3.49 the Team race was ours. Brian Newcombe did not get a look in with his 1.4.09. Only two riders started the Sydenham '25' Chris Gray finished in 1.6.0 and Harry Corby 1.5.24. Out on the Bath Road Kohn Gallo collected a puncture on his way to a 2.15.40 in the Belle Vue '50'.

The 31<sup>st</sup> July was the Club Open '50' down on the Bath Road and Pangbourne Lane. It was an excellent day for the Paragon with Robin Buchan coming home with the fastest time of 2.1.51. Tony Kerss, still with the Clarencourt, was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2.3.37. Don Ward finished with 2.5.51 and John Gallo 2.10.46 to make up the winning Team. Our sympathies must go to Brian Newcombe who, again, was 4<sup>th</sup> man but this time with a time only 2 seconds slower than John Gallo. Our only other finisher was John Llewellyn with 2.12.59. Closer to home Vic Boreham did 1.7.40 in the Farnborough Middlemarkers '25'.

Following this it was John Llewellyn's turn again on the 7<sup>th</sup> August. He won the Eltham Paragon '25' with a 1.1.37. Brian Stocking and Chris Gray well up with rides of 1.5.17 and 1.6.52 so the Paragon won the Team race. Going up to 30 miles it was another win for Robin Buchan in the Redmon '30' with a 1.11.09 ride. Don Ward finished in 1.13.29 and Alan Large 1.13.41 for the Paragon to collect their second Team race of the week-end. John Gallo did 2.8.53 in the Bournemouth Arrow '50' and Harry Corby rode 227 miles 787 yards in the South Eastern RC 12-hour event.

On the 14<sup>th</sup> August we were not quite so prolific. Robin Buchan produced a 59.21 in the Farnborough '25' but was 1.28 behind the winner. However close bunching by Alan Large 1.0.10 and Johnny Llewellyn 1.0.22 ensured the Team prize came to the Paragon. John Gallo lost 10 minutes with a puncture in the Addiscombe '50' to finish in 2.20.53.

A quiet week-end on the 21<sup>st</sup> Mickey Vickers finished in 2.5.44 in the Southend and County '50' and John Gallo did 2.9.22. John Llewellyn had a puncture that ruined all thoughts of a Team race. Brian Newcombe rode the SCCU '50' and recorded 2.12.55.

There were lots of people racing on the 28<sup>th</sup> August. John Llewellyn won the West Kent '25' in 1.0.23 which was one better than Robin Buchan. Robin 'only' came 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Southgate '25' with a 58.59 missing the win by 4 seconds. Don Ward finished in 1.0.28 and Brian Newcombe 1.4.20 to complete the winning Team. On local roads the Club had its own '50' with John Gallo winning in 2.7.14. Alan Baxendine was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2.10.01 and John Smart 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2.17.09. Alan took the handicap by over 4' from John (2.0.01 to 2.4.14) with Rick Tutton collecting 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

On an unspecified date Gerry Edmunds won the Surrey Centre 5 miles Championship and the Club Team pursuit Squad beat the Poly in the Final of the London Centre Team Pursuit. The team riders were Robin Buchan, Pete Smith, Wally Happy, Alan

large and Don Ward. The Track secretary reported 20 first places and 23 second or third places this year.

What a day the 4<sup>th</sup> September was! John Llewellyn finished in 57.25 to break the existing Club 25 miles record when along came Robin Buchan to finish in 57.14! With Don Ward crossing the Finish line in 58.23 the Paragon not only won the Team race but set a new Competition Record of 2.53.02. Robin also collected 2<sup>nd</sup> place and one should also mention Ron Palmer who finished somewhere out of the frame with a 1.3. The rest of the Club were going about their business in the Regent '50' where Chris Gray collected 3<sup>rd</sup> Handicap with a 2.8.50 ride. John Gallo finished with a 2.9.16, Alan Baxendine 2.14.46 and Brian Newcombe 2.14.50. John Cleeve went a bit better with 3<sup>rd</sup> fastest and 2<sup>nd</sup> handicap in the Rodney '50' with a 2.16.14 ride. Paul Jaeger also finished in 2.28.42. Pete Tilley won the Barnet 23 miles event at Stapleford Tawney. His first massed start victory.

There was a mixed bag of results for the 11<sup>th</sup> September. John Llewellyn was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Ruxley Whs '50' with 2.6.16 and Mickey Vickers did 2.8.17. Robin Buchan completed the 29<sup>th</sup> Whs '25' in 57.25. John Gallo finished the SCCU and Club 12-hours event with a very creditable 239.13 miles. In Essex Chris Gray did 1.3.03 and Brian Newcombe 1.4.0 in the ECCA '25'. But failed to win any medals (You do not get prizes in ECCA events – even in 2004!)

Yet another Club Record went on the 18<sup>th</sup> September when John Llewellyn and Robin Buchan teamed up to ride the Old Portlians Tandem '30'. They scorched round the course in 1.1.31 to win the race and to break the Record. Don Ward and Gerry Edmunds completed the course in 1.6.08 to enable the Paragon to take yet another Team race. Out in Kent John Gallo and Alan Baxendine were riding the Medway RC '100' with disappointing results. John finished in 4.48.03 and Alan 5.7.45 but you don't usually do fast times on Kent courses as they are rarely flat.

Tony Kerss turned the tables on Robin Buchan in the Redhill '50' beating him by 25 seconds to win in 2.3.38 to Robin's 2.4.03. It should be added that Tony Kerss won this '50' on a number of occasions almost making the event his own. Chris Gray finished in 2.10.43 and Alan Baxendine 2.20.10. Out west John Gallo and Brian Newcombe were riding the Hounslow '25' both finishing with 1.3 rides. Brian had 9 seconds and John 21.

Twenty-one riders met the Timekeeper for the Mayne Cup '25' on the 2<sup>nd</sup> October. This was also an Inter-Club race with the Kentish Wheelers and it is very true to say this type of event really brings out the best in our racers. Johnny Llewellyn had his turn in the limelight by beating Robin Buchan by 17 seconds (John's 1.0.32 to Robin's 1.0.49). The 3<sup>rd</sup> Paragon counter was John Gallo with a 1.4.17. Next were Brian Newcombe, 1.4.18, Brian Stocking, 1.4.55 and Chris Gray 1.5.04 to complete the Paragon team that won by nearly 6 minutes. The Man-of-the-Day to take home the Mayne Cup was John Vallack from Alan Sturgess and Brian Newcombe. Unfortunately no handicaps or handicap times have been recorded.

The next week-end to round of the Club racing scene Robin Buchan won the Club Hill Climb on Ranmore in 4.12. 2<sup>nd</sup> place went to Chris Gray in 4.27 who just pipped Brian Newcombe by 1 second.

Mickey Vickers, 2.19, and John Llewellyn rode the Catford Hill Climb but were unplaced. Mr Vickers and Brian Newcombe also rode the Ealing Manor Christmas Day '25' for their sins. Mickey did 1.4.21 and Brian 1.7.13.
